2. The Director of Medical Education was directed to cause inspections at the premises of the CSI College of Dental Sciences and Research, Madurai with reference to the Dental Council of India norms and send the inspection reports along with her specific recommendations.



3. The Director of Medical Education has nominated inspection teams for conducting inspections and sent her reports and recommendation about the desirability and feasibility for starting MDS courses.

4. The Government after verifying the desirability and feasibility, convey permission / Essentiality Certificate to start the following MDS courses in the CSI College of Dental Sciences and Research, Madurai from the academic year 2015 – 2016 with annual intake noted against each specialty, subject to condition that the shortage in journals, equipments and other deficiencies pointed out by the Inspection Team in respect of MDS Courses in Conservative Dentistry, Oral Pathology, Orthodontics and Periodontics should be rectified by November 2014 as per undertaking given by the College authorities and the approval of the Dental Council of India and Government of India should be obtained before the students are admitted to the respective courses and approval of the Directorate of Town and Country Planning should be obtained in due course:
